

Notice During COVID-19 Pandemic

STOP AND DO NOT ENTER IF:

- You have symptoms of or currently have COVID-19 (Cough, Fever, Chills, Muscle Pain, Sore Throat, Lost of Taste or Smell, and Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing).
- You are a healthcare professional who cares for COVID-19 patients.
- You have been exposed to or are caring for those with COVID-19.
- You are especially vulnerable to COVID-19 due to age or an underlying medical condition.
- You have attended any crowded events/parties/other parishes where social distancing and safety precautions are not in place within the last 14 days.

UPON ENTERING:

- Wash your hands according to guidelines published by Provincial health authorities, which currently includes using soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
- Always maintain two meters social distancing.
- Observe the directives from the civil health authorities.
- Wear a mask, as directed by local health authorities.
- Do not kiss the icons, the chalice, or the priest's hand.
- Please remain at your designated spot during the service.
- Depart promptly after the service, maintaining social distancing protocols.

CAUTION:

According to the health authorities, older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19, including:

- People with chronic lung disease or moderate to severe asthma
- People who have serious heart conditions
- People who are immunocompromised
- People with severe obesity (body mass index [BMI] of 40 or higher)
- People with diabetes
- People with chronic kidney disease undergoing dialysis
- People with liver disease
- This list is not exhaustive and is subject to change as more information becomes available. Speak with your doctor if you have any concerns and stay at home.

While our parish is taking precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we cannot guarantee that you will not become infected. Attending services may increase your risk of contracting a life-threatening disease such as COVID-19, especially if you are over 65 year old or have an underlying health condition. By entering, you voluntarily assume this increased risk of exposure or potential infection with COVID-19.
